Staff Parish Relations Committee (SPRC) Update

Recently the SPRC reviewed the job descriptions for our Facilities and Office Managers. This was important since they had not been updated in about five years and many of the present SPRC members were not on the committee during the last revision.

Both staff members were also asked to review their job descriptions, to make sure they accurately reflect what they are doing. For instance, our Facilities Manager Chad is now solely responsible for the cemetery grounds, so it was important that tasks associated with the cemetery were included. In Office Manager Lori's case, she now performs the treasurer duties, so there was a list of tasks that had to be added.

While Pastor Tim is their immediate superior, SPRC is the committee that hires, reviews performance, and sets salaries and benefits. The Facilities Manager has an extra layer of supervision, since it is the Trustees who set the tasks associated with the church building and grounds, as well as the cemetery. Having an accurate description of both jobs keeps everyone on the same page, especially as SPRC members and Trustees change.

During the SPRC discussion, it was decided that a paragraph regarding character traits should also be included in all job descriptions as follows:

Christian values are a requirement. It is imperative to be professional, respectful and have a positive attitude when interacting with fellow staff members, church members, worshippers, and visitors. Negative comments and gossip are not acceptable; confidentiality is required.

While the committee felt this was important for staff members, they also agreed it was essential for everyone in leadership to follow, so the paragraph was shared at the last Council meeting. The more I thought about it, EVERYONE at Grace should be working on these traits, whether we are greeting a visitor, participating in a committee meeting, or simply conversing with one another.


In a recent Lenten Bible Study session, we discussed how each of us is
