FROM THE PASTOR

Pentecost, 2023

Greetings in the Triune Persons of God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit!

There is a long, long history of discussion and debate about the three-fold nature of the Godhead (as “God in three Persons, blessed Trinity” from the great hymn “Holy, Holy, Holy”, is formally called). One of the best summaries of the ‘orthodox’ (meaning ‘right/correct doctrine’) is the ‘Gloria Patri’ – from the Latin first words: Glory be to the Father – itself. It’s in our Hymnal in two tunes, #70 or #71, and is often sung after an Affirmation of Faith (usually one of the historic Creeds, from the Latin ‘Credo’ – ‘I believe’, the first word of the Apostles’ Creed). The song simply names the three Persons – Father, Son and Holy Spirit – for us to ascribe glory and honor to. Significantly, it does NOT try to explain the fact that Christians believe that there is one GOD in three PERSONS; it simply declares it for us to sing our praises to.


Many cults of Christianity – such as the Jehovah’s Witnesses and Mormons/Latter Day Saints, Unitarians/Universalists – will tell you that there is no word “Trinity” in the Bible and so we should not say there is. They are correct insofar as this Latin word is not found in the New Testament, written in Greek as it was.

But throughout and behind the Bible is the Triune God:

The Father who creates and whose covenant love for us caused him to send the Son, the 2nd Person of the Trinity, who was with the Father and the Spirit at creation itself. The Son’s Incarnation as Jesus, fully God and fully man, whose Death and Resurrection was the Triune God’s means to redeem and save us from the eternal consequences of our sin and rebellion: death.

And, at Pentecost, we celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, the 3rd Person of the Trinity, equally God with the Father and the Son, “who with the Father and the Son is worshiped and glorified.” (The Nicene Creed, finalized in 325 A.D.) The Holy Spirit is called ‘the Sustainer’, both of the creative works of God and of our faith, and He is ‘the Revealer’, convincing and convicting our hearts and minds of the need for ‘that hole in ourselves no other can fill except God’ (St. Augustine) and is the Author Who lies behind the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments which “reveal to us everything necessary for faith and practice” (the many catechisms (instructions in the faith) and confessions).

One famous image helping us understand the Trinity as the Bible presents God in three Persons - Father, Son and Holy Spirit – looks like this:



Perhaps the most detailed expression of the Trinity comes from the so-called “Athanasian Creed”, named after the Church Father Athanasius who lived in the 300s A.D. The Creed known by his name comes from the late 500s-early 600s, probably in what’s now southern France, but is certainly as orthodox as its famous namesake. It now is included in the Global Methodist Church as one of the official Creeds.

Reflect upon its deep dive into the wonder of God-in-three-Persons:

The Athanasian Creed (On the Doctrine of the Holy Trinity)

Whosoever will be saved, before all things it is necessary that he hold the catholic [i. e., universal, Christian] faith. Which faith except everyone do keep whole and undefiled, without doubt he shall perish everlastingly. And the catholic faith is this, that we worship one God in Trinity and Trinity in Unity, Neither confounding the Persons nor dividing the Substance. For there is one Person of the Father, another of the Son, and another of the Holy Ghost. But the Godhead of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost is all one: the glory equal, the majesty coeternal. Such as the Father is, such is the Son, and such is the Holy Ghost. The Father uncreate, the Son uncreate, and the Holy Ghost uncreate. The Father incomprehensible, the Son incomprehensible, and the Holy Ghost incomprehensible. The Father eternal, the Son eternal, and the Holy Ghost eternal. And yet they are not three Eternals, but one Eternal. As there are not three Uncreated nor three Incomprehensibles, but one Uncreated and one Incomprehensible.

So likewise the Father is almighty, the Son almighty, and the Holy Ghost almighty. And yet they are not three Almighty's, but one Almighty. So the Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Ghost is God. And yet they are not three Gods, but one God. So likewise the Father is Lord, the Son Lord, and the Holy Ghost Lord. And yet not three Lords, but one Lord. For like as we are compelled by the Christian verity to acknowledge every Person by Himself to be God and Lord, So are we forbidden by the catholic religion to say, There be three Gods or three Lords. The Father is made of none, neither created nor begotten. The Son is of the Father alone, not made nor created, but begotten. The Holy Ghost is of the Father and of the Son, neither made nor created nor begotten, but proceeding. So there is one Father, not three Fathers; one Son, not three Sons; one Holy Ghost, not three Holy Ghosts. And in this Trinity none is before or after other; none is greater or less than another; But the whole three Persons are coeternal together and coequal, so that in all things, as is aforesaid, the Unity in Trinity and the Trinity in Unity is to be worshiped. He, therefore, that will be saved must thus think of the Trinity.

I know this is dense but in a time when people from some of the Christian cults come knocking at our doors, and we meet others from other faiths altogether, we must know what we believe. This was and is the purpose of all the Creeds: to provide the people with a summary of what the Bible says about God.

On Pentecost we celebrate the Holy Spirit, whom Jesus gave as ²⁶... the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you. ²⁷Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid."

My friends, brothers and sisters in Christ, who with the Father and the Holy Spirit, lives and reigns, one God, for ever and ever: "Be not afraid."
